


## Pop Art Disney Drawings



















#### CJHS & CHS Choir, Drama, & Piano

## Arizona State Seal of Arts Proficiency

This diploma seal is administered by the Arizona Department of Education's Office of Arts Education and is awarded to graduates who complete minimum arts pathway requirements throughout their high school career.

This year is the first year of the program for Coolidge students.

To qualify, students need:

- 4 minimum credit requirements in one of the following ways:
  - A minimum of 4 credits in one artistic discipline:
     (dance, music, theatre or visual arts) OR
  - 3 credits in one artistic discipline, and 1 qualifying creative industries CTE credit or separate artistic discipline. OR
  - 2 credits in one artistic discipline, and 2 credits in a qualifying creative industries CTE class or a separate artistic discipline.
- Sufficient documentation for ALL of the following:
  - A final GPA of 3.0 or 4.0 in each qualifying arts course.
  - 80 hours of arts related extracurricular activities for 2023 graduates and beyond
    - 2022 graduates need 60 hours
  - A student capstone project
