Dear, CUSD families and Community Partners:

As of this morning there have been two new positive COVID-19 cases within Coolidge Junior High of students who attended school yesterday. These new positive cases brings the total of 7th and 8th grade students under quarantine to 272 because of possible exposure to the students who have tested positive.

Beginning immediately, August 18, 2021, Coolidge Junior High School will transition to remote learning through August 29, 2021. Students will be allowed to return to campus on Monday, August 30, 2021.

During this time, students will be required to log into their classes using Microsoft Teams, communicate with their teachers through email and/or iMessage, and submit assignments through Apple SchoolWork.

Coolidge High School is not impacted by this quarantine at this time. If your child has siblings in other grade levels, they **will not** be required to quarantine at this time. This would be considered “exposure to exposure”. We ask that you watch for any symptoms of COVID-19 and inform the school site with any other positive COVID-19 results.

All junior high athletics and activities will be postponed until August 30, 2021.

This is an unfortunate circumstance, but one we knew could happen. We are committed to the health and well-being of all our students and staff and want to ensure we can remain open for in-person learning.
